



Pharmacist Review

Pharmacist review is suitable for:

A. Individuals aged

- Older than 2 years to 17 years old with one parent present OR
- 18 years or older

B. Those with symptom(s) such as:

- Blocked/Runny nose
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Allergies
- Constipation
- Diarrhoea
- Skin itch
- Dry eye
- Muscle strain

C. Where NO Medical Certificate (MC) or Time Chit is required.

If pharmacist review is suitable for you, please read the information below before proceeding to the pharmacy to get a queue number.

Please note:

- Not all conditions need medication. The pharmacist may include lifestyle tips to help you better manage your symptoms, without the need for medication.
- The pharmacist will not be able to supply medication that requires a doctor's prescription.*
- Without a doctor's prescription, some medications can only be supplied in limited quantities or only to patients above a certain age*.
- Your personal particulars may be recorded for certain pharmacy-dispensed medication.*

Payment Matters

- There is no fee for the pharmacist review; only the recommended medication is chargeable.
- There is no government subsidy (e.g. Pioneer/Merdeka Generation) and medication is non Medisave-claimable.
- Financial assistance schemes such as Medifund/Public Assistance, or medical benefits such as the Civil Service Card cannot be utilised.
- Patient name may not be reflected on the receipt depending on medications recommended.

If the pharmacist assesses that your condition is not appropriate for self-treatment, you may be advised to see a doctor for further management of your condition.
